We're dedicated to serving transplant patients and their caregivers before and after surgery by providing a warm family atmosphere and amenities needed for daily living. We offer you and your caregiver temporary and affordable housing during the entire transplant process.

Apartments include:

- Television with basic cable
- · Wireless internet
- · Washer and dryer

- · Small appliances
- · Bed linens and towels
- Cookware and kitchenware

Requirements

- You must live outside a 50-mile radius of Baylor University Medical Center, part of Baylor Scott & White Health.
- All reservations must be made by a transplant coordinator, administrative assistant, scheduling coordinator or social worker.
- · You must have an adult caregiver accompany you at all times.
- All adult occupants age 18 or older must pass a background screening.
- · All accommodations are subject to availability.



What to bring

- Personal food, medication and personal hygiene items (including soap and hangers).
- Cleaning supplies for laundry, dishwashing, floors, appliances and furniture.
- Paper products, including paper towels, toilet paper, tissues and trash bags.

Checking into Twice Blessed House

- Instructions for check-in and how to obtain apartment key fob and mailbox key are provided by our staff the day before your scheduled arrival.
- Arrive no earlier than 12:00 PM on check-in day.
- A packet of paperwork will be in your assigned unit. Complete and return according to the instructions provided.

Checking out of Twice Blessed House

- Checkout time is 12:00 PM. If you check out afterward, you may be charged for an additional day.
- Drop off keys in the return key box mounted below the check-in lock boxes. Contact the office if additional assistance is needed.
- A blue laundry bag is in your unit. Place all dirty linens in the bag and leave it in the laundry area.
- Do not leave food, dirty dishes or trash in the unit.

Rules

- Maximum occupancy for a one-bedroom unit is three occupants; a two-bedroom is four occupants. Children over the age of 1 are counted as an occupant.
- Notify us if children will be with you.
 They must be supervised at all times.
- No smoking of any kind is permitted in the apartments.
- No alcohol, illegal drugs or firearms of any kind are permitted.
- · No pets of any kind are permitted.
- One vehicle per unit is permitted and must be registered prior to check-in. Unregistered vehicles are subject to towing.

- One key fob and one mailbox key will be issued for each unit.
- Lost fobs are \$75 to replace. Lost mailbox key is \$75 to replace. The fee to replace the TransCore Parking Tag is \$75, which can only be paid by money order made out to "The Case Building."

Financial obligations

- Rates: One-bedroom unit \$50 per night.
 Two-bedroom unit \$70 per night.
- Payment: Credit or debit cards and personal checks are accepted forms of payment.
 No cash, money orders or cashier's checks will be accepted.
- Two background screenings, for you and your caregiver, are processed free of charge.
 If you have more than two background checks processed, there is a charge of \$5 per screening.
 Please pay for additional screenings at the time of check-in.

Miscellaneous

- Shuttle service to hospital: Monday Friday,
 5:30 AM 9:00 PM, every 15 minutes on the westbound curb next to the Case Building at Main Street near Hall Street.
